PAGABON

Would you like to have better control over your electricity consumption? Pagabon is the solution! Pagabon is the prepaid system of WEB. It is easy to use and offers many benefits.

Benefits of Pagabon

- you can manage your electricity consumption much better;
- you can decide how much electricity you want to use and buy;
- you will use electricity more efficiently;
- you will become observant to what you consume and how you can save in and around the housealso check our folder 'Save';
- you will no longer receive energy invoices; hence, no surprise at the end of the month and
- you can avoid overdue payment and all its consequences.

Pagabon meters

WEB currently has two models of Pagabon meters:

- Model A: a system with a power cable (this is an older model)
- Model B: a system with wireless control

Customers who have applied for a Pagabon system before November 2013 are using Model A. Since November 2013 new clients of the Pagabon system receive Model B.



Application for Pagabon

For your application for the Pagabon system it makes a difference whether there is an existing electricity connection or not. If you have a temporary electricity connection, you cannot yet submit an application.

You don't have an electricity connection

To apply for Pagabon you must submit the following documents:

- a cadastral drawing (situational drawing);
- a valid ID with a clearly recognizable picture;
- an inspection card* for the permanent connection of electricity.

* The inspection, the completion and signing of the inspection card must be carried out by an approved installer. The inspection card can be obtained at the cash desk of WEB.

If you're not the owner of the plot, then you are required to hand over a signed power of attorney (not older than 6 months) and a copy of the owner's ID.

If you are renting a house from Fundashon Cas Bonairiano (FCB) we request you to include a stamped letter by FCB.

You already have an electricity connection

We ask you to notify the application for the Pagabon system to us and submit the following documents:

- a certified copy from the Land Registry (Kadaster)
- a valid ID with a clearly recognizable picture
- the meter numbers

If you not the owner of the plot of land then you are required to hand over a signed authorization (not older than 6 months) and a copy of the owner's ID.

Processing your request

Once the application, including all the required documents, is complete we make an appointment with you to assess the situation on site. If civil work (ground work) is required for a permanent connection, the procedure may take longer.

Once you have paid the connection costs, we will make an appointment with you to install the Pagabon meter. After installation the Customer Service department will activate the system. You will then receive the Pagabon instruction card, on which you can write your meter number. On the purchased electricity credit you can read your meter number and your client number.
